# **Excellent registration figures for ORGATEC 2018**

Around six months before the start of the event, ORGATEC 2018 is already almost fully booked. 554 companies have already confirmed that they will be attending as exhibitors, that is 6 percent more compared to the same period of time in 2016. Among them are 409 non-domestic companies from a total of 37 countries. There will be a particularly strong presence from companies from Italy, Spain and Denmark. In addition, there will be group participations from China, Hong Kong, Italy (3), Korea, Portugal, Spain and Taiwan. In 2016, approximately 56,000 trade visitors travelled from around the world to Cologne to discover new launches and trends in furnishing, flooring, acoustics, lighting, and media and conferencing technology at ORGATEC.
